FINDINGS OF FACT**

**ARKANSAS RESIDENTIAL CONTRACTORS COMMITTEE**

**vs.**

**JAG ENTERPRISES, INC**

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that JAG Enterprises, Inc. shall pay a civil penalty of \$104,400.00 for violation of Act 950 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days and refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee.

**ELITE HOMES OF ARKANSAS, INC.**

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that the license of Elite Homes of Arkansas, Inc. is hereby revoked for misconduct. Elite Homes of Arkansas, Inc. shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee.

**GILBERT HARVEY, D/B/A FRENCHIES CONSTRUCTION**

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that Gilbert Harvey, d/b/a Frenchies Construction shall pay a civil penalty of \$9,750.00 reduced to \$4,875.00 if no further violations for 2 years for violation of Act 950 payable to the Committee

within twenty (20) days and refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee.

**ERNEST MALLOY, D/B/A ERNIE MALLOY CONSTRUCTION**

**ORDER**

The Committee voted unanimously that Ernest Malloy, d/b/a Ernie Malloy Construction shall pay a civil penalty of \$3,000.00 for violation of Act 950 on the project in Gosnell; \$3,735.00 for violation of Act 950 on the home in Marmaduke for a total of \$6,735.00 payable to the Committee within twenty (20) days. The Committee also issued order of abatement prohibiting Ernest Malloy, d/b/a Ernie Malloy Construction from doing any work in violation of this law. Ernest Malloy, d/b/a Ernie Malloy Construction shall refrain from bidding on or performing work as a residential contractor prior to being licensed with the Residential Contractors Committee.
